

How to apply to be a registered musician at a festival.

We have a limited number of spaces available to street musicians to play during the festival. These are not paid positions and each registered musician must comply with all of the Festival rules listed below:

- You will need a permit issued by Festivals of Cedarburg, Inc. to play on the street for Strawberry or Wine & Harvest Festivals—you can request the permit by emailing the information requested below to cedarburgfestivals@yahoo.com
- All other festivals – check with the City of Cedarburg for permit information
- You can only play in the area that you are assigned by Festivals on the permit.
- You can only play for the times you are scheduled to play as listed on the permit, which is determined by Festivals. All permits have a 2-hour limit. You can request a time slot on both days of a Festival.
- If you are asked to stop playing by a nearby merchant or vendor, you are to stop playing immediately. You can contact Festivals for new placement - a cell phone number will be provided on the permit.
- You are not allowed to use a microphone or amplify the music of any kind.
- No electronic devices to play music are permitted.
- Panhandling is permitted.
- No signage or cases that block the street or sidewalks will be permitted. Do not use the merchant buildings to post signage or attached anything.
- No offensive music or language will be tolerated.
- You must carry the permit with you while you are playing. If anyone asks to see the permit, please provide it to them.

Aside from complying with the above rules, those age 17 and older:

- Send the name(s) for all musicians, contact information, cell phone numbers, genre of music and instrument(s), to the email address above, times/days when you would like to play.

Aside from complying with the above rules, those age 16 and younger:

- A parent must remain with with any child age 16 or younger for the entire time of the performance.
- Panhandling is permitted as long as a parent is with the musician 16 years old or younger.
- Send children's names, ages, and both parent's cell phone numbers, days/times the children will be play (2 hour-limit per child) to the email listed above.
